

## **Water again**

We have had some beautiful days so far this year. The sun has warmed us up and helped everything to grow so beautifully. There is only one problem with beautiful summers like this one, and that is keeping everything watered. When the weather is hot and dry it takes a lot of water to keep plants and grass looking their best. It becomes difficult to keep up. Most often we have to make sacrifices, water our favorites and leave the rest to survive on their own. Unless you have an automatic irrigation system it's next to impossible to keep your entire yard growing at its optimum performance.

Watering is extremely important when you first plant a new tree or shrub, the potted root ball is denser than the loose backfill soil so it takes a lot of extra water to penetrate to the roots. Trees or shrubs that have just been planted take one to five years until they have a big enough root system to support themselves sufficiently. Therefore, it is much harder for them to gather all the water and nutrients that they need to flourish. On large transplants it is best to leave a hose on a slow dribble so the roots never start to dry.
